The sponsored long walk is our usual one along the entire line starting from Alton

A shorter option is
'THE SPONSORED DOWNHILL'
This goes from Medstead and Four Marks station to Alresford
(about 6 miles all downhill or level)

Or finally **'THE 'FAMILY STROLL'**
This goes from from Ropley station to Alresford
(about 3 miles all downhill or level)



All walks start or end with a free vintage bus ride from Alresford to Alton and the intermediate stations.

Whichever station you walk from the starting time is between 10.00 and 11.00.

Please note that walkers arriving at Ropley after 15.30 cannot continue walking and will be taken onto Alresford by vintage bus.

Free tea, coffee and soft drinks are available at the intermediate stations (Medstead & Four Marks and Ropley) as well as Alresford.

First aid facilities and toilets are available at all stations.

A full range of refreshments will be on sale from the West Country Buffet at Alresford station.

CAR PARKING

Alresford, pay & display in the station car park. Buses will leave Alresford at the start and end of the walk to serve all three stations.

Ropley; there is nowhere to park at Ropley so please come to Alresford and take the bus.

Medstead & Four Marks; there is limited on-street parking but please think of our neighbours and park on the Medstead side.

Alton: SW Trains (or maybe South Western Railway by then) Pay & Display is available and also the car park in the Catholic Church on the corner of Papermill Lane (Pay & Display)

No need to notify us in advance, just turn up on the day.

The Heritage Lottery Fund has granted £895,000 for the restoration of our Merchant Navy Class 35005 Canadian Pacific. We have to raise a further £605,000 in matching funds in order to receive the Lottery funding.
