


CAR PARKING IN ALRESFORD

Car parking in Alresford is very limited, although not expensive. The following information may be helpful. Please note that on certain occasions (e.g. Watercress Festival, MHR Special Events) different rules apply. You should also be aware that a Parking Warden regularly patrols the town.



AWT = Average walking time.

① ALRESFORD STATION CAR PARK

(Winchester City Council)

Mon-Sat: £1.50 for 4 hours or more. Suns: No charge.

Immediately outside the station. Watch out for areas reserved for staff, coaches and parking restrictions in connection with the transhipment of locomotives.

② PERINS CAR PARK

(Winchester City Council)

Lower Car Park, Jacklyns Lane.

Mon-Sat: £1.50 for 4 hours or more. Suns: No charge.

DRIVING THERE. From the Station Car Park follow the blue overflow parking signs downhill along Station Approach (parallel with the railway). Turn right at the end into Jacklyns Lane and Perins (Lower) Car Park is shortly seen on the left.

WALK BACK in the reverse direction following signs to the railway. AWT 4'30''.

③ PERINS CAR PARK

(Upper Car Park, Pound Hill)

Saturdays and school holidays only. Suns: closes 1 p.m.

No charge.

DRIVING THERE. You will probably try the Lower Car Park first (see above). If this is full, exit and turn left into Jacklyns Lane and at the cross-roads turn left into Pound Hill. Pass the Fire/Police Station on the left and Perins Upper Car Park is shortly found on the same side, signed **PERINS HEALTH & FITNESS SUITE/P SATURDAYS & SCHOOL HOLIDAYS**. (On school days this is reserved for staff parking.)

WALK BACK downhill to Perins (Lower) Car Park and then follow instructions as from there. *AWT 6'00"*.

④ ARLEBURY PARK CAR PARK

(Winchester City Council)

Sun-Sat: £1.50 for 4 hours or more.

DRIVING THERE. From the Station go downhill along Station Approach (parallel with the railway). Turn right at the end into Jacklyns Lane and at the cross-roads turn left into Pound Hill. Pass Perins (Upper) Car Park on your left and shortly **NEW ALRESFORD TOWN COUNCIL/ALRESFORD RECREATION CENTRE** is signed. Turn right, into the entrance.

WALK BACK in the reverse direction. *AWT 8'30"*.

ELSEWHERE IN THE TOWN CENTRE

Car parking is also available in West Street and Station Road (before 6 pm 1 hour, no return within 1 hour; Suns no restrictions); and Broad Street (before 6 pm 2 hours, no return within 2 hours; Thursday limited owing to presence of market; Suns no restrictions). These parking bays are intended for the convenience of shoppers and those using other facilities. New Alresford is a compact town, laid out around the year 1200, and although there are plans for more car parks it will be some years before these are constructed (if at all).
